There was an extravagant claim made at the April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023 council meeting that 400 families are involved in hockey and 300 in figure skating. Clearly, this is a Venn diagram situation where there is overlap of the two groups. But, with only a pool of 841 kids, we might expect a <u>maximum</u> of one-third participation, or 280. By the Town's February 2017 report, there were only 220 MoWest children in CRA ice activities, and it's doubtful if there was a large uptick in participation.
